*A Lesson on AVA's*

The Willamette Valley AVA (American Viticultural Area) encompasses 6 different sub-AVA's. Each AVA is a designated area defined by a number of factors including elevation, climate and, most importantly, soil. Each of these distinct factors contribute different elements to the wine. In order for a wine to be AVA specified, all of the grapes used to produce the wine must be from one specific AVA.

Our cellar consists of over 50 Oregon Pinot Noir's and are listed by the AVA in which they are made. We encourage you to try a new and different wine on each of your visits, here or anywhere. You will be surprised what a difference each AVA can have on the same grape, the distinctive Pinot Noir. Cheers!
